Now there's a stayer on the case of trying to get wheelchair access to platform two at Geelong station.

So the Lift Shop, which told us it had been in business 11 years and gets lifts from Italy, says it would have absolutely no problems in getting the right lift to do the job here without mucking up the heritage aspects of the station.

Its roll wheelchair stair lift is supplied complete, which includes installation, testing and commissioning with 12 months' after-sales service, and it's ours for about \$28,000. Of course, there'd be another \$28,000 for the other side of the station, but surely, in the scheme of things, that's chickenfeed.

We'll keep at it. We will get there.
